



## FINAL REMINDER - CAMPS, SPORTS AND EXCURSIONS FUND (CSEF) 2020

### FINANCE /JOB SEEKER

To be eligible for the fund, a parent or guardian must be the holder of a concession card being successfully validated with Centrelink on the first day of either Term 1 2020 (28<sup>TH</sup> January 2020) or Term 2 2020 (15<sup>TH</sup> April 2020).

The CSEF is an annual payment to the school from the Victorian Government to be used towards camps, sports and/or excursion expenses for the benefit of the eligible student. Primary School Student Rate is \$125.00 per year.

### PLEASE NOTE:

For parents/ guardians who have recently applied for the Government's Job Seeker support due to the COVID-19 and now hold a Health Care Card, please check the card start date. If it is prior to the 15<sup>th</sup> April 2020 then your children are eligible for Camps, Sports and Excursions Funding (CSEF) of \$125.00 per student. The CSEF is paid directly to your child's school.

Please note the lodgement date for the school has been extended to **24<sup>th</sup> July 2020. We advise that we are unable to lodge applications after this date.**

Please phone Heather in the the school office to have an application form sent to you and we will lodge an application for CSEF on your behalf.

# GET INTO GOLF


MyGolf is Australia's introductory golf program for 5 to 12 year olds.
