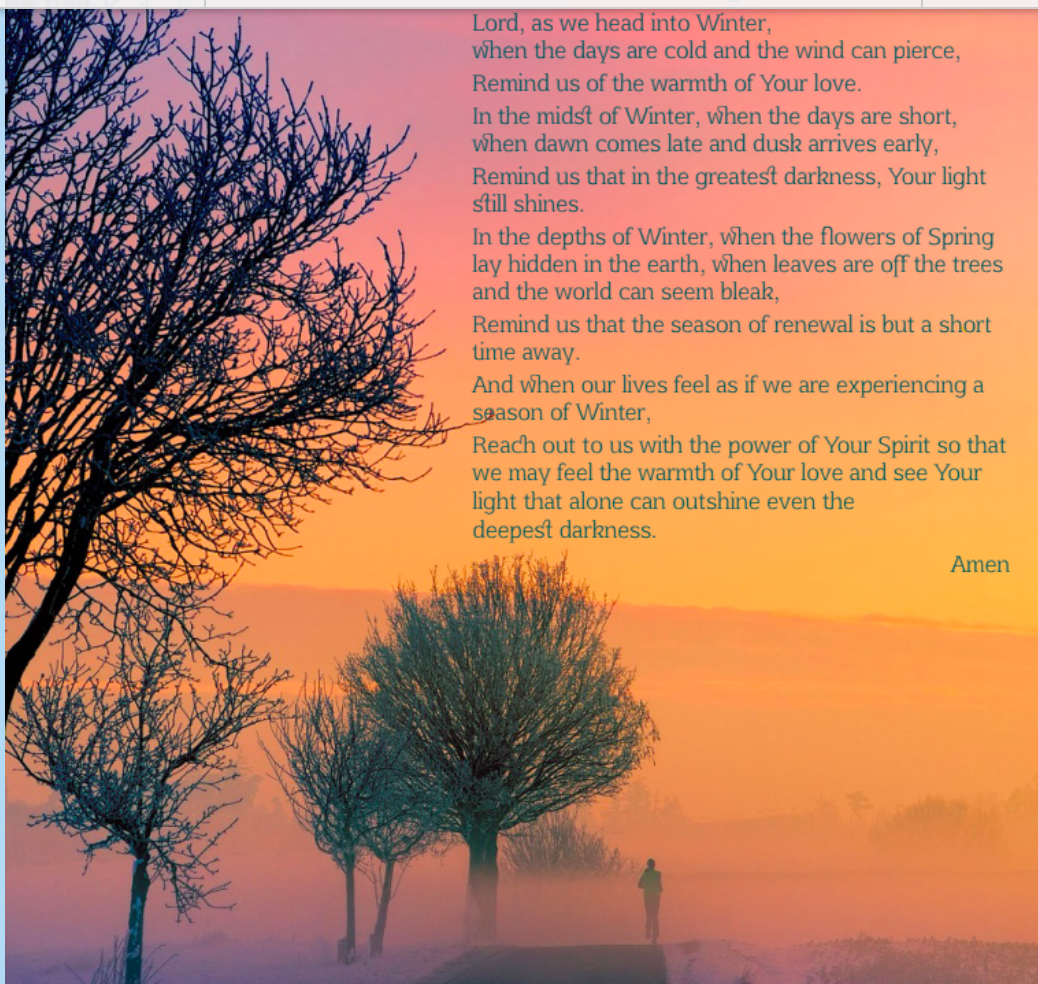

**There was something quite magical about Tuesday. There was a lot of excitement, nervousness and embraces as students returned to school. The transition thus far has been very smooth. Students returned to their 'new normal' routines with little fuss. We are thrilled to finally hear prayer, discussions, chants and laughter fill our learning spaces.**

positive feedback you have given us whilst we have been engaged in Remote Learning. It is very humbling to know we are part of such a thoughtful and appreciative community.

Just a reminder regarding pick up at the end of the day. The staggered pick up is only for students being picked up by car at the Orr street school entrance. All other students will be dismissed at 3.15pm. I cannot legally allow a child to leave school grounds unaccompanied by a parent / carer prior to 3.15pm.

Students who are being picked up by car need to be picked up from the Orr street entrance only (not Woods Road) at the red bollards at the end of the driveway. Students being picked up by car will be dismissed by their surname:

Student with Surname A - I - 2:30pm

Students with Surname J - R - 2:45pm

Students with Surname S - Z - 3:00pm

Bus children: will be dismissed at the regular time of 3:15pm.

Bike children: will be dismissed at the regular time of 3:15pm.

Walking children will be dismissed at the regular time of 3:15pm - if being picked up by a parent, parent to wait at driveway gate. No parents to come onsite or congregate in groups.

Although we are all back at school many restrictions are still in place to ensure that we all stay well. This involves parents and other adults not entering the school - thank you for compliance and patience with this requirement.

Due to the school closure and remote learning, reports will look a little different this semester. Reports will be sent home for each child, however the content covered and comments on learning will be different. We will be holding a Parent Forum (just like the remote learning forums) through Google Meet to discuss the differences in this Semester's report. The Forum will be held on Thursday 18 June at 10 am.
