Deepest sympathy to Miss Van Roy and her family on the passing of her brother, Joe. Our thoughts and prayers are with you.



HATS

A reminder to all students, that they must be wearing their navy wide brimmed hat each day. We are a sun smart school, which requires hats to be worn in 1st and 4th terms. Please label your child's hat clearly.

Diaries

The Leadership students have been given a diary for the year. Year Five students will be using their diary for their Reading Log. Students are required to read a total of 80minutes for the week. Each night students read they must record the book they read and get it signed off by an adult. The Year 5 students need to bring their diary along to school each day. This will take a little bit to get into routine. We ask parents to please support this and remember to sign off and remind students to pack in bag each day. The Year 5's will also use their diary for upcoming events and things that need to be remembered. Each Friday the teachers will collect diaries and sign off for the week.

<u>School uniform</u> Students are reminded to be wearing the correct uniform. The Year 5's will have sport on a Friday. On this day students may wear runners, sports uniform and socks with a logo if they wish. All other days must be black shoes and plain white/ socks. The Year 6's have sport on a Tuesday & Friday.
