We hope to have all children and families join us at the concert. We sing many of Andrew's songs at our masses and liturgies and the children love singing his songs. Hope to see you there.


Term One has finished and over the next few days we commemorate and celebrate the death and resurrection of Jesus. Please take the time to remember the most important week in our Church year.
