Every day, thousands of women and children around the world need to cover many kilometres to fetch water, obtain food, get to school or market, or simply to survive.

By participating in Caritas Ks we provide the opportunity for our students to walk in the shoes of these women and children and others less fortunate while raising money for Caritas Australia. We are asking for a note donation from each family to donate to this worthy cause.

The walking will commence after recess and we will finish with a free sausage sizzle. If any parents are able to help in the cooking of the BBQ please email me.

The children will walk as a team named after one of the country's Caritas does great work in, through Project Compassion. We encourage the students to dress in the colours of the country's flag or something symbolic of the country.
