

(A loose paraphrase of 1 Corinthians 13:1-6)

I may be able to speak with authority in the assembly hall and teach with skill in the classroom; I may lecture brilliantly on a wide variety of subjects: I may appear on television panels about education and write bestselling books on the subject, but if I have no love for my students, it is not enough.

I may have degrees or diplomas in education; I may be in close touch with the latest trends in teaching and heartily approve of the newest ideas; I may also strongly emphasise knowledge of the basics- but if I have no love for my students, it is still not enough.

Love makes teachers patient and kind. Teachers who love their students are not sarcastic, or rude or unfair. They never bear a grudge. A teacher's love never gives up.




